## God's Word



3. Read Mark 4:35-41, as an occasion where the disciples failed. What do the disciples accuse Jesus of when they waked him? How does Jesus respond and what does he challenge them about their faith? Based on this how can you learn from your failures in following Jesus. Close in prayer thanking God for giving you a second chance when you fail to follow him.
